Dear Mr. Bakko:

This document authorizes and describes the procedures for aircraft to deviate from the requirements of Federal Aviation Regulation Subpart C, Section 91.215(b)(2), during the Discover Aviation Days 2016 at the Anoka County-Blaine Airport (ANE).

Note: This waiver **does not** authorize aircraft to enter Class B Airspace without an ATC clearance.

Any deviation from any portion of this document by the owner/operator deems the document void and the authorization cancelled.

1. Authorization number: **MSP-1602**.
2. Aircraft may operate "without Mode C" within the 30-mile Minneapolis Mode-C veil from 1100Z Thursday, June 2, until 0500Z Tuesday, June 7, 2016.
3. Flights operating under this authorization must be conducted in VFR conditions **below 2,000** feet mean sea level within the area depicted on the enclosed map.
4. No pre-departure or pre-arrival notification is required.
